1

Cut the deadwood. Develop performance standards for agencies and departments, and evaluate their work. If the agency can't produce results, eliminate it.

Establish statewide priorities. Make it clear which programs are essential and make sure they are funded first.

3

Consolidate services. Find the areas where responsibilities overlap between agencies and consolidate them to save money and increase service.

4

Clear out unused inventory. Review the unused equipment and land owned by the state. If there are no firm plans for using them, sell them off and return the money to the state budget.
