### ***Assemblyman revamps campaign website, prepares for 2010 election***

Las Vegas – Assemblyman William Horne launched his revamped campaign website today in preparation for the 2010 Election. The website, [www.WilliamHorne.com](http://www.WilliamHorne.com) is unique and unlike most campaign websites.

Assemblyman Horne described the idea behind his website after it went live in early February, “I’ve always tried to make my campaign less about me, and more to provide resources and a service for my constituents.” Visitors to the website can visit links to help update their voter registration, calendar important 2010 election dates and learn more about Assembly District 34.

Horne explained further, “I’ve included links to resources that I use to serve my constituents and for my own family. The resources range from links to foreclosure mediation for constituents fighting to stay in their homes to fun activities for families to do on a Saturday afternoon.”

Other areas of resource include links to volunteer health organizations, Clark County schools and education groups, consumer affairs, financial tips, family and child friendly and politics and elections sites.

In addition to providing helpful information, the site also details Horne’s background, legislative accomplishments and endorsements. Horne described his favorite page on the site, “I first ran for the Assembly to answer questions and serve the public. The Q&A page on my site gives voters the opportunity to ask me questions and have my response posted online for everyone to read.”

William Horne is currently serving his fourth term in the State Assembly.
