## **Assemblyman William Horne files for third term**

*Former Outstanding Freshman and highly rated sophomore sets goals for next legislative session.*

Las Vegas—Assemblyman William Horne, a former Outstanding Freshman Assemblyman and highly rated sophomore legislator, filed for re-election to a third term today.

Horne, who authored successful legislation to rein in governmental use of eminent domain and another measure to attack the spread of methamphetamine production, is already setting goals for the 2007 legislative session. “Eminent domain is definitely high on my ‘to do’ list,” Horne stated.

“As the parent of toddlers and teenagers, I’m very concerned about our school system,” Horne said. “I support the overall program of reforms recently offered and look forward to working on them from my position on the Education Committee.”

Horne is also a member of the Health and Human Services Committee where he sees more work ahead in that committee and in the Assembly on health care issues.

Horne is a graduate of Western High School, UNLV, the Boyd School of Law at UNLV, and has his own law firm. He is married with two younger children and two teenagers.
